Dalida (Born Yolande Christina Gigliotti January 17, 1933) was an Egyptian-born singer, of Italian origin, who made her career in France. Dalida recorded 500 French songs, 200 of which were translated into Italian, and 300 into other languages. She sold more than 150 million albums world-wide, winning numerous awards, scoring more than 70 gold records. Yet, despite her fame and fortune, her personal life was difficult and filled with much drama and tragedy. On May 3, 1987 Dalida died as a result of an overdose of sleeping pills. She is buried in the Cimetière de Montmartre, Paris, her gilded life-size statue one of the most outstanding of the many sculpted works in the famous cemetery.



*The full song Gigi L'Amoroso (Gigi The Lover) is 7 minutes long – it is a whole story, with three spoken parts. Gigi is a singer in a little village near Naples, he is handsome and charming and all the women in the village are in love with him. Every Saturday night he sings and the whole village listens and dances ...until one day .... he falls in love with an American woman who takes him away to the USA and the village weeps but is also proud to see its hero on his way to international fame. Years go by and then, one evening, Gigi comes back, in tears. The village welcomes him with joy and convinces him to start singing again in his village where he is admired and cherished.*

*Dalida used this song, again and again, as the last one of her show, which is why the song starts: “Je vais vous raconter, avant de vous quitter, l’histoire d’un petit village près de Napoli.....” Dalida received 9 oscars for this wonderful song.*
